Fifth Grade School Supplies

Books are the property of the school and are on loan to the children for the school year. Parents will be required to pay for any books, including library books, which are lost or defaced. It is the responsibility of the student to keep a book cover on hardbound classroom textbooks that go home with a student. Books are to be carried to and from school in a book bag.

The annual registration fee is used to purchase textbooks, workbooks, testing materials and associated scoring costs, classroom magazines, and additional curricular and instructional items.

All items on the following list are to be furnished by the student's family. Students need to bring the following supplies with them on the first day of school. The teacher will notify the family when supplies are running low and need to be replaced.

Classroom

- A book bag - rolling or regular backpack styles
- A number of pencils - #2 lead pencils in the standard or automatic pencil styles
- Two (2) packages of washable markers
 - A set of 8 basic colors in the broad-tip style
 - A set of fine-tip style markers
- A box of crayons - 24 colors, thin style is preferred
- A box of colored pencils – If these are to be used in art class, the teacher has requested Crayola-brand or art-store quality pencils. The other, less expensive brands break easily and do not work well in the pencil sharpeners.
- A dry-erase marker – any color
- A pair of scissors
- A glue stick
- A bottle of glue
- A pencil eraser
- A 12-inch metric ruler
- A line compass for Math
- A protractor for Math
- A four function calculator for Math
- A 1/8", 6 inch ruler for Math
- An eight (8) pocket folder
- A red ball-point pen or pencil
- A blue or black ball-point pen – permanent pens must be used for tests; erasable pens can be used for other work
- A soft-side, zippered pencil case. Please do not purchase hard-side pencil cases. They do not fit in the desks. Large freezer bags can be used if desired.
- A box of tissues
- 5 book covers. If they don't stretch, you will need extra large size

Paper

All paper must be wide-ruled. College-ruled or paper torn from spiral notebooks will not be accepted by the teachers.

Notebooks & Folders

Each student is expected to have seven (7) one-subject, wide-ruled spiral notebooks one for each of the following subjects; Math, Science, Social Studies, Religion, English, Literature, and Computer.

Spanish

- A two-pocket folder
- A wireless notebook – this type of notebook is not a spiral notebook or a composition book. It is designed to have pages that can easily be removed if needed without the pieces of hanging paper left from a spiral notebook.

Music

Please send \$4 the first day to purchase a recorder to be used in music class.

Art

The classroom teachers and art teacher have requested that children bring a separate bag filled with the following art supplies. Please label the bag with your child's name. The supplies will be stored separately and used only for art class. This new process is designed to better organize supplies and speed up the transition to art class.

- A washable glue stick
- An 8 oz. bottle of washable glue
- A pair of scissors
- A few #2 pencils
- A pencil eraser
- A 16-count package of thin-style crayons in classic colors
- A 12-count package of Crayola-brand or art-store quality colored pencils in classic colors. The other, less-expensive brands of colored pencils break easily and do not work well in pencil sharpeners.
- A set of markers in classic colors with a medium tip. The style is sometimes called conical or bullet style. Please do not purchase chisel style, extra fine, or broad tip markers
- A kneaded art eraser
- A 12-inch ruler
- Optional: A hand-held pencil sharpener
- Optional: A drawing compass

Note: In any grade where an art portfolio was used, please bring the portfolio back to school this year to be used again.

White-Out and felt tip pens may not be used in the classrooms. Permanent markers are also not acceptable in school.
