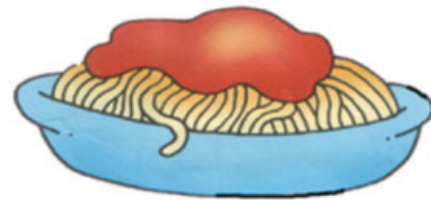
## The Next Chapter

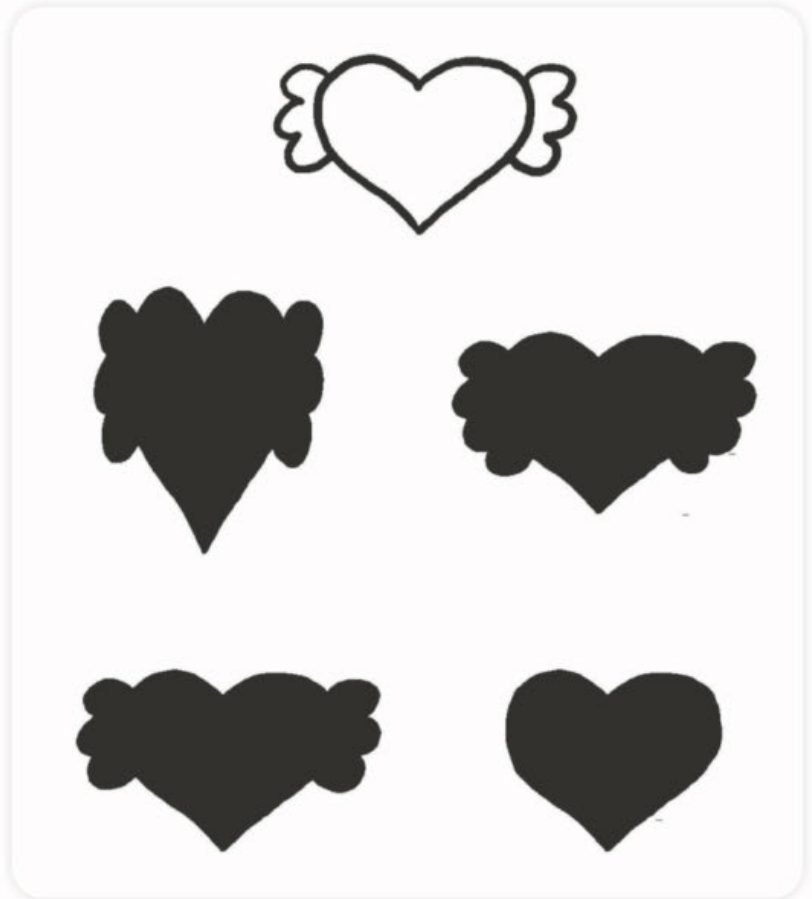
